The Department of Motor Vehicles is pleased to inform you that the American Safety Council's New York Motor Vehicle Accident Prevention online course has been approved under the Internet/Alternate Delivery Method Point and Insurance Reduction Program (I-PIRP) pilot program in New York State.

You may begin offering the I-PIRP course to the public on Monday, May 18, 2009 beginning at 12:01AM Eastern time.

This pilot program will last for five years during which time the Department will study the effectiveness of these alternate methods for delivery of the course and report its findings to the governor and the Legislature pursuant to Article 12-C of the Vehicle and Traffic Law.

Pursuant to the regulation, you are required to continue providing classroom courses. We will notify you if this requirement is changed at any point in the future.
